Background

Purpose of the Role

To manage the proper and efficient expediting of all contracts, taking custody once negotiations are confirmed and contract forms are issued. To negotiate and agree all forwarding related costs. The Logistics Manager has a responsibility to work closely with the Trading Department and Engineering Department to understand their requirements and fulfil the agreed terms of their contract. They are the first point of reference to approve deviations to contract and any changes to the brief. The Logistics Manager will also work closely with the Documentary and Accounts departments to ensure that the required documents are supplied and where appropriate relevant invoices are authorised and passed for payment.

Based in the London office, the Logistics Manager will be the internal forwarder to the Longulf Group.

Key deliverables (Essential duties and responsibilities)

- The basis of Longulf's proposition is its ability to deliver physical goods to their end users both in the trade of manufacturing substrates and in the delivery of engineering projects or spare parts. A strong logistics knowledge and understanding of forwarding is therefore a requirement to the job.
- The jobholder will work with shipping lines, freight forwarders and port agents in order to ensure that business propositions are based on reliable logistics solutions which are using competent suppliers in order to achieve efficient, claim free and price competitive logistics.
- The jobholder will acquaint himself with the technical aspects of the products and services which are part of Longulf's proposition.
